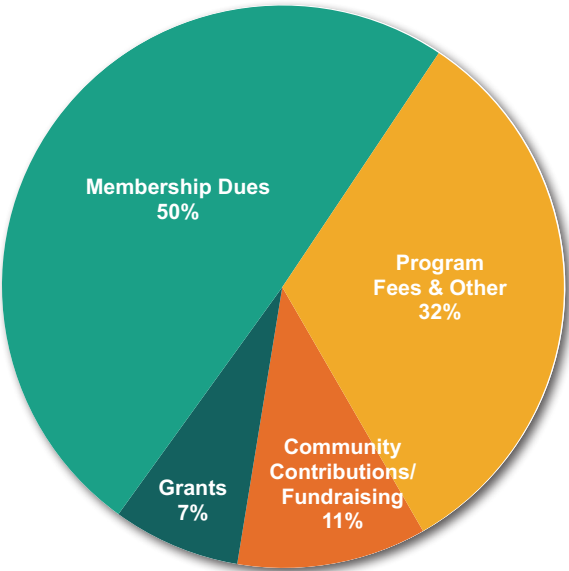
PAUL HANUS, FACILITY MANAGER

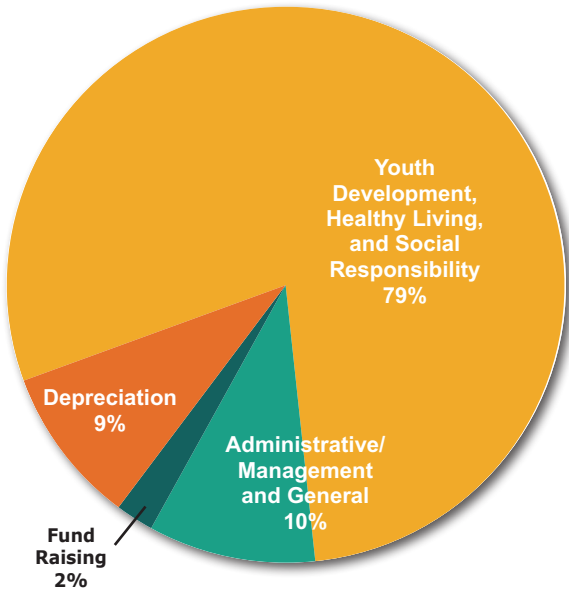

CROSSFIRE LACROSSE

The 2023 Cadillac Area YMCA Crossfire Lacrosse Program saw two co-ed age groups play this year. Fourteen and Under, coached by Gavin Hoffman saw an elite squad of 13 athletes compete this year. Fourteen U Crossfire competed against Traverse City, Petoskey and Sault Ste Marie. Twelve and Under had a class of 9 athletes this year, coached by Todd Foster and Nicholle Messer. Twelve U also competed against Traverse City, Petoskey and Sault Ste Marie. Our season starts in February when the teams practice indoors at the Wex until they can move outside. Once outside games begin and the work starts to pay off. Games start in early May and run through June, concluding with a Round Robin Tournament hosted by the Crossfire Lacrosse Program. This year saw some great games and close nailbiter finishers.

This program doesn't end in June for these athletes, many of them spent the summer recruiting and helping out at programs throughout the community as well. Whether it was walking in the Lake City and Cadillac Fourth of July parade to promoting lacrosse and team sports at the Mitchell Street Market Shutdown. This sport never stops for these athletes. The 2024 season kicks off February 26th and we're always looking for athletes. Go Crossfire !

CAMP: A FAMILY TRADITION

Laura Porter first attended Camp Torenta in 1970 beginning a family tradition, one that is similar to that of many others within the Cadillac community. BACK TO SCHOOL CARNIVAL

There can be many barriers for children from low-income families to be successful in school. Our Back to School Carnival is an event we do each year to try to lessen the burden on these families and help them provide their kids with tools and resources for them to have a successful school year. In 2023 our Back to School Carnival saw over 450 people from all over our area. With the assistance of great organizations like Cadillac Community Foundation, United Way, Great Start Collaborative and many more, we were able to provide families with 160 -\$25 gifts cards for new shoes, 200 backpacks, over 100 free haircuts, new school clothes, and much more. The need is great, and we hope to increase our reach and resources in 2024.

CHILDCARE & PRESCHOOL INFORMATION FOR 2023:

DAYCARE/EXTENDED CARE:

28 FAMILIES were **SERVED** in our childcare for 2023. We are a licensed childcare facility that can serve children 2.5 – 12 years of age.

DILLON DAY CAMP:

29 FAMILIES were **SERVED** in our 2023 summer program. Dillon Day Camp is a summer childcare program for children 6-12 years of age.

HEAD START:

Head Start concluded in August of 2023.

11 FAMILIES were **SERVED** during the summer of 2023 for Head Start.

GSRP:

State funded, September thru May/June, preschool readiness program for 4-year-old children. From January – May 2023 **8 FAMILIES** were **SERVED** in our GSRP program. We currently are **SERVING 16 FAMILIES** in our 2023-24 GSRP program. Our GSRP program scored an amazing 6.56 out of 7 in Emotional Support for children in our care during our fall CLASS (Classroom Assessment Scoring System) observation. CLASS is an observation instrument developed to assess classroom quality in preschool through third-grade classrooms.

WHAT'S NEW IN THE TEEN CENTER

The Teen Center has implemented several new programs in the past two years. Thanks to the Healthy Out of School Time Grant, each week the teens are provided an organized physical activity by one of our physical trainers, Luke Schihr and encouraged to try a new healthy snack with Deb Dyer. The Y is also providing a Lego Robotics program on Thursdays, provided by Susan Stoll. On the days that these programs are not being offered, we're offering a STEM based academic enrichment activity delivered by one of our Teen Center Staff. The STEM and enrichment activities are supported by a grant from the Michigan Department of Education.
